1. This application is filed on behalf of the Plaintiff for enlargement of time to deposit the Court fee.
2. It is stated in the application that the amount calculated towards the Court fees comes to Rs. 7,71,690/- and Plaintiff has affixed Rs. 4,000/- on 21.04.2025. For the balance amount of Rs. 7,70,000/-, Plaintiff had initiated online transfer through his bank i.e., Punjab National Bank, Laxmi Nagar, Delhi, vide transaction No. 512312752070 on 21.04.2025, however, as per bank record while the stand amount stands duly deposited in the account of the Plaintiff but on checking from the court fees purchase counter of Delhi High Court, Plaintiff was informed that the amount has not been credited in the Stock Holding account.
3. Accordingly, for the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed, permitting the Plaintiff to deposit the Court fee within ten days from the receipt of balance amount of Rs. 7,70,000/- from the Stock

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Holding.

4. Application stands disposed of.

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5. Let plaint be registered as a suit.

6. Upon filing of process fee, issue summons to the Defendant, through all permissible modes, returnable on 29.08.2025 before the Joint Registrar.

7. Written statement shall be filed by the Defendant within 30 days from the receipt of summons along with affidavit of admission/denial of the documents filed by the Plaintiff.

8. It is open to the Plaintiff to file replication within 30 days from receipt of the written statement along with affidavit of admission/denial of documents filed by the Defendant.

9. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.

10. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of any documents, the same be done in accordance with Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

11. List before the learned Joint Registrar for completion of service and pleadings, marking of exhibits and admission/denial of documents on 29.08.2025.
