2. Application stands disposed of.

3. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking following reliefs:

“a. Issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ in favour of the Petitioner and against the respondent thereby directing the respondent especially respondent no. I/school to allow admission to the ward of the Petitioner namely master Fayan in class Nursery!Pre-School under EWS/DG/CWSN category in the academic session 2025-26 in the said school without any further delay.”

4. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submits that



petitioner applied for admission of his ward in pre-school under the category of EWS/DG/CWSN. He submits in March 2025, respondent no.2/DOE through computerized draw of lots declared the result, in which petitioner's ward was allotted a seat in respondent no.1/school. However, respondent no.1/School is denying admission to the petitioner's ward and has not even issued admission form despite petitioner's repeated visits to the school.

5. In view of above, issue notice. Mr. Abhinav Sinha, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent no.2/DOE accepts notice. On a query posed by the Court, he affirms the position that petitioner's ward was allotted a seat in the respondent no.1/School.

6. Let counter-affidavit be filed within a period of four weeks. Rejoinder thereto be filed within two weeks thereafter.

7. On petitioner taking steps, issue notice to the respondent no.1/DAV Public School by all permissible modes returnable on 12.08.2025.

8. In the meanwhile, respondent no.1 School is directed to grant provisional admission to the petitioner's ward in terms of the allotment made by respondent no.2, subject to outcome of the present writ petition.
