ORDER

23.12.2025

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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. *Vide* order dated 21.05.2025, learned Predecessor Bench of this Court while noting that the SLP filed on behalf of the Union of India against the judgment dated 26.02.2024, passed in W.P. (C) 3445/2020, of which, compliance is being sought, was dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 13.05.2025, by giving two months' time to the respondents to comply with the said order, listed the matter for compliance on 24.09.2025.
3. On 24.07.2025 on an application, **C.M.APPL. 44271/2025**, moved on behalf of the petitioner, this Court after hearing learned CGSC had recorded as under: -

“4. Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner submits that despite the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court for compliance within 2 months w.e.f. 13.05.2025 and also the statement given before this Court on 21.05.2025, no progress has



taken place.

5. Learned CGSC on advance notice, on instructions of Mr. Raj Kumar, DIG Law, CRPF submits that the process involves examination of documents of more than 2000 officers, therefore it had taken time and now it has been approved and approval has been sent to Ministry of Home Affairs and seeks further time of 10 weeks for compliance of the order dated 26.02.2025 in W.P.(C) 3445/2020.”

4. On 12.11.2025, learned CGSC on instructions, submitted that the department has been asked to file a review petition against the order dated 13.05.2025 passed by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in SLP (C) Diary No. 22235/2025. It was submitted that the said review petition had been filed *vide* Diary No. 58454/2025.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the said review petition is lying in defects.

6. Learned CGSC submits that admittedly, the matter has not been listed for hearing.

7. In these circumstances, the respondents are in complete violation of not only the order dated 24.07.2025 as well as the order passed by the Hon’ble Supreme Court on 13.05.2025.

8. Even otherwise, apart from the aforesaid statement made on behalf of the learned CGSC, a status report which has been placed on record, records that the subject file is pending with the Ministry of Home Affairs.

9. Let the concerned Director of PS-II appear before this Court on the next date of hearing.
