ORDER

1. It transpires that an SLP filed against the judgment/order dated 26.02.2024 in W.P.(C) 3445/2020 (of which contempt is alleged in the present petition), has been dismissed by the Supreme Court.
2. The Review Petition which came to be filed thereafter, has also been dismissed by the Supreme Court.
3. Mr. Bhardwaj, learned standing counsel submits that the respondents are in the process of complying with the directions contained in the aforesaid judgment/order dated 26.02.2024. It is assured and undertaken by the Director, Ministry of Home Affairs and the DIG, CAPF (who are present



in Court) that necessary compliance in all respects shall be done as expeditiously as possible. It is emphasised that an elaborate inter-department/inter-ministerial consultation would be required for implementation of the aforesaid directions.

4. Let the necessary compliance in all respects be done latest within a period of 3 months from today.

5. In the event of non-compliance, this Court shall be constrained to take appropriate action for wilful disobedience of direction/s of this Court, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

6. In the event of non-compliance, the concerned officials of the Ministry of the Home Affairs shall remain present in Court on the next date of hearing.
