ORDER

1. The present application has been filed seeking exemption from filing certified copies of *Annexures CP-1 to CP-6*, appended to the captioned petition.



2. Exemption allowed, subject to filing of the same, within a period of four weeks, from today.

3. Application is accordingly, disposed of.

CM APPL. 55436/2026 (For directions)

4. The present application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking necessary directions against the respondents.

5. Learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that *vide* the judgment dated 26th February, 2024, the writ petition filed on behalf of the petitioner herein, being W.P.(C) 3445/2020, was allowed, wherein, directions were given to recalculate the grant of the Non-Functional Selection Grade (“NFSG”) by including the posts held by Assistant Commandants as well as the post held by the Indian Police Service (“IPS”) on deputation.

6. Earlier, the present petition was disposed of by this Court *vide* order dated 13th January, 2026, on the undertaking of the respondents that the aforesaid judgment shall be complied with.

7. It is submitted that despite having been afforded sufficient opportunities by this Court, and despite the challenge to the said judgment before the Supreme Court being unsuccessful, the respondents have continued to withhold the implementation of the directions issued therein.

8. It is further submitted that the respondents have now issued an order dated 28th July, 2026 which is purportedly in compliance with the judgment dated 26th February, 2024. However, under the guise of implementation, the respondents have sought to re-calculate the grant of NFSG, by including the posts held by the Assistant Commandants (Senior Time Scale) as well as the posts held by IPS officers on deputation, while simultaneously restricting the



benefit to the petitioners alone, and granting the same only prospectively.

9. It is submitted that such a stipulation is against the letter and spirit of the said judgment.

10. Accordingly, issue notice.

11. Notice is accepted by learned counsel appearing for the respondents.

12. Let reply be filed, within a period of four weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks, thereafter.
