3. The present application under Section 151 of the CPC seeks the following prayers:

- “a) Pass appropriate directions for non-compliance of Judgement dated 26.02.2024 passed by this Hon'ble Court as well as the Order dated 13.05.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court; and
- b) Pass any such orders as the Hon'ble Court may deem fit in the light of above mentioned facts and circumstances of the case.”



4. Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner submits that despite the direction given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court for compliance within 2 months w.e.f. 13.05.2025 and also the statement given before this Court on 21.05.2025, no progress has taken place.

5. Learned CGSC on advance notice, on instructions of Mr. Raj Kumar, DIG Law, CRPF submits that the process involves examination of documents of more than 2000 officers, therefore it had taken time and now it has been approved and approval has been sent to Ministry of Home Affairs and seeks further time of 10 weeks for compliance of the order dated 26.02.2025 in W.P.(C) 3445/2020.

6. In view of the above, no direction is called for and the application is accordingly disposed of.
