1. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant submits that the respondents have submitted the detailed list of the legal heirs of the deceased respondents.
2. He further submits that the appellant has no objection to implead the legal heirs of the deceased respondents, as per the list given by the respondent.
3. This Court notes that in the reply filed by the respondents, they have



given the correct details of the legal heirs.

4. Accordingly, this Court notes the statement of learned counsel appearing for the appellant that they shall file Amended Memo of Parties for impleading the legal heirs of the deceased respondents, as per the list given in the reply of the respondents to the impleadment applications.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents submits that if the legal heirs are impleaded, as per the details provided by them, they have no objection if the present applications are allowed, to that extent.

6. Accordingly, it is directed that the legal heirs of the deceased respondents are allowed to be brought on record, in terms of the details, as given by the respondents, to which the respondents have no objection.

7. Let Amended Memo of Parties be filed by the appellant within a period of one week from today.

8. Noting the aforesaid, the aforesaid applications are accordingly disposed of.
