1. This is an application under Section 151 CPC filed on behalf of the petitioner society for issuing necessary directions and for compliance of order dated 27.05.2022 and 26.02.2024.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are 60 flats in the society in which there are about 250 residents staying, but there is no water since 11.06.2024.
3. Learned counsel for Respondent No. 2/DJB states that water to the society is being provided against the payment of requisite charges and that a DD of Rs. 2 lakhs was deposited by the DDA on 11.06.2024 and pursuant

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thereto, water supply is being maintained through tankers for the residents of the petitioner society.

4. However, this position is controverted by the learned counsel for the petitioner as also by the learned counsel for DDA. The learned counsel for DDA states that the tender for the tankers has already been awarded by the DDA and despite depositing the requisite charges, the water supply is not being maintained by the Delhi Jal Board.

5. Let, both the respondents file their short affidavit in this regard before the next date.
