ORDER

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27.05.2022

1. On 26.04.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“1. Apropos order dated 19.04.2022, Mr. Sanjay Katyal, learned counsel for the DDA, states that a short affidavit has been filed. Even though the same is not on record, Mr. Katyal has handed over a copy of the same in Court today. The relevant portion of the said affidavit reads as under:-

“2. That the respondent no.1 has already commenced the supply of Water to the petitioner Society through ‘Water Tankers’ (by procuring the Tankers from another site) which supply shall ‘duly continue’ until the formal Tender in respect of ‘Water Tankers for petitioner Society’ is floated and awarded with the approval of Competent



Authority. Further and after the award of tender for 'Water Tankers' the consequent supply (through Water Tankers) shall also continue until the process of laying down of peripheral water and peripheral sewer lines is completed, thereby ensuring uninterrupted supply of water to the petitioner all through."

2. Mr. Sanjay Katyal, learned Standing Counsel for the DDA states that they will continue to provide water supply till final arrangements for pipelines are made. He further states that as far as laying down of sewer lines is concerned, approval of the Delhi Jal Board is required for which steps have been initiated and approval from the Delhi Jal Board is awaited.
3. Reply from the Delhi Jal Board is not on record. Let reply be filed within four weeks from today.
