1. This application has been filed by the applicant/Petitioner seeking an Action Taken Report ('ATR') from Delhi Development Authority ('DDA') and Delhi Jal Board ('DJB') with respect to the decisions taken at the meeting dated 16.12.2022.

1.1. The learned standing counsel for Respondent No.1, DDA and Respondent No. 2, DJB states that the said ATR will be filed within a period of one (1) week, with respect to the decisions taken at the meeting dated 16.12.2022.

2. During the course of hearing, the learned counsel for the Petitioner



has stated that the due to delay in arranging the provision of basic facilities/amenities by DDA and DJB, the residents of the Petitioner society are suffering due to lack of adequate water and sewage facilities.

2.1. In reply, the learned standing counsel for DDA has fairly submitted that a meeting can be held between the representative of the Petitioners and the concerned Executive Engineer ('EE'), NMD-II on 31.05.2023 at 11:30 am at NMD-II, DDA, Mukherjee Nagar, opposite BBM. Bus Dept of Delhi. He states that in the said meeting, the representative of the Petitioner can make representation with respect to the difficulties being faced by them and find an amicable temporary solution for the existing issue.

2.2 The residents of Petitioner society are directed to visit the office of EE, not exceeding three (3) persons.

3. The learned counsel for the Petitioner states that their immediate concern is with respect to water supply and disposal of the sewage.

2.3 The Respondent are directed to look into the concerns raised by the Petitioner and find an amiable solution to the issue. The Respondent Nos. 1 and 2 are directed to take an empathetic view of the difficulties being faced by the residents of the Petitioner and extend facilities/amenities to the society as is being done for other citizens of Delhi.

4. With the aforesaid directions, the present application is disposed of.
