1. Ms. Anjana Mishra, the learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents has pointed out that against the order dated 01.09.2021 passed in W.P.(C)No.9324/2021 of which contempt has been alleged, the respondent's school has preferred an LPA No.439/2021, which is pending consideration before the Hon'ble Division Bench of this court.
2. On the other hand, Mr. Khagesh B. Jha, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that in the aforesaid LPA, again an undertaking has been given by the respondent school that they will make the



payment of arrears in terms of VIIth Central Pay Commission (CPC). He submits that since the same was not paid, a contempt petition has also been filed in the said LPA as well, in which a direction has been given by the Hon'ble Division Bench to the DoE to compute the arrears to be paid to the petitioner.

3. It appears that relief sought in present contempt as well as the contempt filed in the aforesaid LPA overlap each other.
4. Let learned counsel for the petitioner place on record a copy of the contempt petition filed in the LPA, as well as relevant orders passed by the Hon'ble Division Bench in the said contempt petition before the next date.
5. Re-notify on 14.08.2025.
