I.A.8928/2025 (Delay of 14 days in filing replication)

1. Heard on the instant I.A. which is an application seeking condonation of delay of fourteen days in filing replication. It be noted that the delay of fourteen days remains within the overall period of forty five days in filing the replication.
2. In the interest of justice, the same stands condoned. The replication is taken on record.
3. The application stands disposed of.

I.A.8929/2025 (Delay of 75 days in re-filing replication)

4. There seems to be delay in rectifying/re-filing the replication. The reasons have been explained during the argument.
5. Under these circumstances, the delay of seventy five days in re-filing



the replication is condoned.

6. The application stands disposed of.

I.A.36420/2024 (by plaintiff – u/O I R 10 CPC)

7. Learned counsel appearing for the plaintiff seeks liberty to withdraw the instant I.A.

8. Accordingly, the same stands dismissed as withdrawn.

I.A.31289/2024 (for injunction)

9. It be noted that *status quo* order dated 30.05.2024 is already in operation. Under the aforesaid circumstances and in order to preserve the subject matter of the dispute and to prevent possible alteration or destruction of material evidence, it would be appropriate to make the order of *status quo* absolute. The said order relates to data and documents, and in effect restrains the defendants from deleting, modifying or disseminating the same until the pendency of the civil suit.

10. The instant I.A. stands disposed of.

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11. Let the main matter to continue before the Joint Registrar in accordance with the extant rules.

12. List before the Joint Registrar on 12.11.2025.

13. Thereafter, the Joint Registrar shall assign the date for listing the matter before this Court.
