I.A. 13553/2025 (Condonation of delay)

1. Heard.
2. For the reasons stated in the application, the same stands allowed. The delay of 50 days in filling the suit stands condoned.
3. The application stands disposed of.

CS(OS) 356/2025

1. The plaint be registered as a suit. Issue summons. Mr.Sunil Dutt Dixit, learned counsel on behalf of the defendants is present. He confirms the receipt of the suit paperbook and waives the right of formal service of summons.
2. Written statement shall be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of summons. The defendants shall also file affidavits of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the



written statements shall not be taken on record.

3. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replications thereto within thirty days after the filing of the written statements. The replications shall be accompanied by affidavits of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendants, failing which the replications shall not be taken on record.

4. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.

5. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

6. List this matter before the concerned Joint Registrar for further proceedings in accordance with extant rules on 18.09.2025.

7. Thereafter, list before the Court on the date to be assigned by the concerned Joint Registrar.

I.A. 13552/2025 (for injunction)

1. Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the plaintiff.

2. Issue notice.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the defendants, accepts notice. He prays for some time to seek instructions and to file the reply.

4. Let the reply be filed within a period of six weeks from today.

5. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed by the plaintiff within a period of two weeks thereafter.

6. List this application for consideration on 01.09.2025.
