1. The instant appeal under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 on behalf of the appellant seeking the following reliefs:

“1) That this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to accept the appeal by setting aside the judgment judgment dated 07.03.2024 passed by Dr. Ruchi Aggarwal, Presiding Officer MACT- 01(CENTRAL), Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi in MACT No. 888/2022 titled as Sh. JankiDass&Ors v. HDFC Ergo General Insurance Co. Ltd.

2) Cost of the appeal be also awarded.

3) Any other relief which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper under the circumstances of the case be also awarded. ”



2. Heard.
3. Issue notice to respondents through all permissible modes on filing PF within one week.
4. This Court is of the considered view that the matter requires consideration. Subject to the appellant's deposition of Rs. 23,75,780/- of the compensation amount along with interest @ 6% per annum before the Registrar General of this Court within a period of three weeks, the operation of the impugned judgment and award shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing. The amount so deposited by the appellant shall be invested in an interest bearing FDR in an auto renewal mode.
5. List on 29th August, 2024 before Joint Registrar (Judicial) for completion of service and pleadings.
