The petitioners contend that they are co-owners of $\frac{3}{4}$ of the property, which has been attached by the impugned order dated 29.07.2019 of the Executing Court, and the judgment debtor is the owner of only $\frac{1}{4}$ of the property in question. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that she made an attempt to ventilate the grievances raised herein before the Executing Court, but was not permitted to do so.
