**I.A. 13518/2025 (for exemption)**

1. This is an application filed by the plaintiff seeking exemption from filing fair and typed copies of the dim documents, which have been filed with the suit.
2. Subject to the plaintiff filing fair typed, clear and legible copies of the dim documents within four weeks from today, exemption is granted for the present.
3. Accordingly, the captioned I.A stands disposed of.

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4. This is a suit filed for recovery of Rs. 4.52 crores approximately.
5. Learned counsel for the plaintiff states that defendant is a partnership firm and he refers to the averments made at paragraph '3' of the plaint.



6. The plaintiff is directed to file an amended memo of parties duly reflecting the name of the partner along with the partnership firm. Let the same be filed within one week.
7. The plaint be registered as a suit. Summons be issued to the defendant by all permissible modes on filing of process fee. Affidavit of service be filed within two (2) weeks.
8. The summons shall indicate that the written statements must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of the summons. The defendants shall also file affidavits of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the written statements shall not be taken on record.
9. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replications thereto within thirty days after filing of the written statements. The replications shall be accompanied by affidavits of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendants, failing which the replications shall not be taken on record.
10. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.
11. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.
12. List before the learned Joint Registrar for completion of service and pleadings, marking of exhibits and admission/denial of documents on **31.07.2025**.
13. List before the Court on **16.10.2025**.
