11. Re-notify on 28 August 2025.

12. For the present, we are only inclined to grant stay of operation of para 11 (d) of the impugned order passed by the Tribunal as it requires the petitioners to amend their policy and, as we have seized with the matter, we deem it appropriate to keep the said direction in abeyance till we take a call thereon.



13. As such, for the present, the operation of para 11(d) of the impugned order passed by the Tribunal shall stand stayed.
