ORDER
10.01.2022

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The hearing has been conducted through video conferencing.

1. As per office report, summons sent to Judgment debtors No.1 to 3 through registered post, speed post, courier and *dasti*, is awaited. As per report of the process server dated 16.12.2021, "Judgment debtors have gone abroad for last two months and not aware when will be back".
2. An affidavit of service has been filed on behalf of decree holder No.1, according to which Judgment debtors No.1 to 3 have been served through email and whatsapp.
3. Hence, Judgment debtors No.1 to 3 are not present despite service.
4. Judgment debtors No.4 & 5 have appeared through counsel, who submit that the subject matter of this petition qua them can be resolved through mediation, to which counsel for decree holder has no objection.

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5. Accordingly, decree holder and judgment debtors No.4 & 5 are directed to appear before Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre on 18.01.2022.
