From the affidavit of assets which has been filed before this Court, it is prima facie evident that an attempt has been made by respondent / Judgment Debtor Nos.4 and 5 to mislead this Court and not to make a candid disclosure of their assets. This is evident from the fact that both brothers who occupy the same residential premises assert paying rent of a sum of Rs. 2,40,000/- per annum.
