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1. Further to the order dated 01.02.2023, Mr. Raghavendra Mohan Bajaj, learned counsel for the plaintiff, states that the plaintiff is agreeable to recording of evidence by a Local Commissioner in terms of Chapter XII of the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.
2. With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, Ms. R. Kiran Nath, former District & Sessions Judge [Tel: 9910384659] is appointed as Local Commissioner to record evidence.
3. At the request of Mr. Bajaj, six weeks' further time is granted as



final opportunity for filing of affidavits of evidence on behalf of the plaintiff.

4. Learned Local Commissioner will thereafter fix the schedule for recording of evidence.

5. Mr. Bajaj states that the plaintiff is likely to examine three or four witnesses. Learned counsel for the defendant states that they are likely to examine two witnesses.

6. Learned Local Commissioner is requested to conduct the proceedings within the precincts of the Court premises. The Registry is directed to make the suit record available as may be required by the learned Local Commissioner.

7. The learned Local Commissioner will be paid a remuneration of ₹30,000/- per session of 2.5 hours to be shared jointly between the parties.
