3. The petitioners seek mandamus, (i) directing the respondents



Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) to re-fix the basic pay of the petitioners with effect from grant of Senior Time Scale (STS) in the minimum of the entry grade in pay band of Rs.15,600-39,100 + Grade Pay of Rs.6600/- for the relevant rank which, in the present case is Rs.18,600/-, for the rank of Deputy Commandant with due arrears and all consequential benefits; or in the alternative; (ii) directing the respondents CRPF to re-fix the pay of the petitioners in the correct minimum entry grade for the relevant rank which, in the present case, is Deputy Commandant by grant of STS in consonance with the relief granted in ***Vinoj V.V. vs Union of India***, 2018 SCC OnLine Del 12714 (DB) [Special Leave Petition (Civil) No. 20583/2019 preferred whereagainst was dismissed on 19th July, 2019 and Review Petition (Civil) whereagainst was dismissed on 4th February, 2020] and subsequently vide order dated 4th August, 2020 in W.P. (C) No.4854/2020 and in ***Malkhan Singh Vs. Union of India*** MANU/DE/1501/2020 (DB).

4. The counsel for the respondents appearing on advance notice states that counter affidavit is required to be filed.
5. Issue notice.
6. Notice is accepted by the counsel for the respondents.
7. Counter affidavit be filed within six weeks, as sought.
8. Rejoinder, if any thereto be filed within further four weeks thereafter.
