I.A. 14025/2025 (for condonation of delay)

1. This is an application filed by the Petitioner under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, seeking condonation of delay in re-filing of the petition under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act ('A&C Act'), 1996.
2. For the reasons stated in the application, the application is allowed and the delay in refiling the petition is condoned.
3. The application stands disposed of.

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4. The present petition has been filed under Section 11(6) of A&C Act, seeking appointment of a Sole Arbitrator for adjudication of disputes between the parties arising out of the Tender Ref. No. CP/T/05/RIB/2019-20 dated 30.09.2019 ('Agreement').
5. Learned counsel for the Petitioner states that the Agreement contains



an arbitration clause i.e., Clause 10 which provides for adjudication of disputes arisen between the parties by arbitration.

6. He states that since disputes having arisen between the parties, the Petitioner sent a legal notice invoked the arbitration clause by issuing legal notices dated 25.06.2022 and 26.07.2022 to the Respondent.

7. For the said reasons, issue notice to the Respondents by all permissible modes, including electronically, upon the Petitioner taking requisite steps within one (1) week from today.

8. In case, the Respondent is opposing the petition, the reply be filed within one (1) week from the receipt of the notice.

9. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within one (1) week thereafter.
