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1. Vide order dated 24.09.2025, it was submitted by the learned counsel for the respondent that an affidavit had been filed on 19.09.2025 placing on record the order passed by the NCLT, New Delhi Bench, whereby a petition under Section 7 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 against the respondent company had been admitted and moratorium under Section 14 of the IBC had been imposed.
2. However, the said affidavit was not found on record, and accordingly the Hon'ble Court directed the learned counsel for the respondent to take steps to have the same placed on record.
