Today's Court proceedings are conducted through hybrid mode.

Counsel for deceased respondent points out to the order dated 15.09.2022 on which date he has informed the Court about the death of the respondent as well as his wife. It was also recorded on the said date that he has provided the details of the legal representatives of the respondent to counsel for the petitioner.

It is a sad state of affairs that the petitioners have taken more than three years just for filing an application under Order 22 Rule 4 CPC for bringing on record the LRs of deceased respondent. However, in the interest of justice and at request of counsel for the petitioners, four weeks further time is granted to counsel for the petitioners to file appropriate application for bringing on record the LRs of deceased respondent failing which, right to file the same shall automatically stand closed.
