The learned counsel submits that the learned Trial Court *vide* Impugned Order dated 16.12.2024 has erred in granting the *interim* maintenance in favour of the respondent to the tune of Rs. 16,000/- per month by solely relying upon the assets and property some of which is ancestral and others are that of his father.
