1. The present appeal under Section 415(2) read with Section 528 of B.N.S.S., 2023 has been filed on behalf of the Appellant against the Judgment on conviction dated 10.03.2025 and the Order on Sentence dated 27.03.2025 passed by the Ld. ASJ-05, North West, Rohini Courts, Delhi in Sessions Case No.56/2017. By the Judgment dated 10.03.2025, the Appellant has been convicted for the offence punishable under Section 302 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act in FIR No.732/2016, registered at Police Station Begumpur. By the Order on Sentence dated 27.03.2025, the Appellant has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life along with a fine of Rs.1 lakh for the offence committed under Section 302 IPC and in case of default in payment of fine, the Appellant shall further undergo simple imprisonment for a period of six months. For the offence



committed under Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, the Appellant has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 03 years along with a fine of Rs.5,000/- and in case of default in payment of fine, the Appellant shall further undergo simple imprisonment for a period of one month.

2. Admit.

3. Let a digitized copy of the Trial Court Record (TCR) be requisitioned before the next date of hearing.

4. On receipt of the Trial Court Record, let the paperbook be prepared by the Registry and be supplied to the learned Counsel for the Appellant as well as the learned APP for the State.
