1. None appears for respondent nos. 1, 2 and 3, though on 08.02.2024, Mr. V. N. Raghupathy, learned ASC had appeared for respondent no.1 and Mr. Maanendra Pal Gupta, learned counsel had appeared for R-2 & 3.

2. Mr. Munjal, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that all the petitioners are octogenarian and are seeking only the extension of the payment of pension, which was stopped from 30.06.2021 on account of closure of school-respondent no. 4 from that day onwards.

3. Learned senior counsel submits that this Court had in the case of same respondent No.4-school in *Kanhaiya Manjhi Vs. Govt. of NCT of Delhi & Ors.* in W.P.(C) 12374/2021 by the judgment dated

02.05.2024 directed the respondent-NDMC to absorb the surplus teachers of the very same school in terms of Rule 47 of the DSER, 1973. He submits that the respondent herein is the same school and since this Court had already directed the NDMC to absorb the teachers therein in various schools run by the NDMC, under Rule 47 of the DSER, 1973, the rationale and the ratio will surely apply to the facts of the present case.

4. Issue court notice to Mr. V.N. Raghupathy, learned ASC and Mr. Maanendra Pal Gupta, learned counsel appearing for the respondent nos. 1 and 2 and 3 respectively for the next date.
