I.A. 14231/2025 (for exemption)

1. Plaintiff shall file legible/original/certified and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules, before the next date of hearing.
2. The application for exemption is allowed, subject to the plaintiff granting inspection of the documents filed, as and when required to do so, or filing the original documents at the stage of admission/denial.
3. The application stands disposed of.

CS(OS) 384/2025 and I.A. 14230, 14232 and 14233/2025

1. Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the plaintiff.
2. Let the plaint be registered as a suit. Let summons of the suit as well



as notice of application bearing I.A. 14230, 14232 and 14233/2025 be issued to the defendants by all permissible modes on the filing of process fee. Let affidavit of service in respect of the same, be filed within two weeks.

3. The summons shall indicate that the written statements must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of the summons. The defendants shall also file affidavits of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the written statements shall not be taken on record.

4. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replications thereto within thirty days after the filing of the written statements. The replications shall be accompanied by affidavits of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendants, failing which the replications shall not be taken on record.

5. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.

6. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

7. List the main civil suit as well as accompanying application bearing I.A. 14230, 14232 and 14233/2025 before the concerned Joint Registrar for taking up necessary further steps and for completion of pleadings in accordance with extant rules on 11.09.2025.

8. Once the pleadings are completed, let the application bearing I.A. 14230/2025 be listed before the Court on the date to be assigned by the concerned Joint Registrar.

9. The prayer for interim relief shall be considered on the next date of hearing.

10. In the meantime, if any third party right is created, the same shall



remain subject to further directions to be passed by the Court.
