12. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of any documents, the same be done in accordance with Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

13. List before the learned Joint Registrar for completion of service and pleadings, marking of exhibits and admission/denial of documents on 09.09.2025.
