ORDER

1. Mr. Kartik Bhagat, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the Judgement Debtor.

1.1. He states that Judgement Debtor could not remain available as he is attending a wedding in Ludhiana.

1.2. He also submits that the Judgement Debtor would like the matter to be referred to Mediation.

2. In this case, the Court has issued bailable warrants against the Judgement Debtor for his presence today. The non-presence of the Judgement Debtor before Court and the reason furnished for the absence; to say the least is unacceptable.

3. The Judgement Debtor is directed to deposit costs of Rs. 20,000/- with Delhi High Court Bar Clerks' Association, through the Secretary within a period of one (1) week. The proof of payment will be filed thereafter.

4. The Judgement Debtor is also directed to file its affidavit of assets in compliance with Order XXI Rule 41(2) of the Code of Civil Procedure,

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1908 (CPC) within four (4) weeks.

5. The Judgement Debtor is hereby restrained from dealing with any of his immovable assets.

6. It has been put to the learned counsel for the Judgement Debtor, if the Judgement Debtor is ready and willing to pay up the amounts due under the decree. He states that he does not have instructions on this. In view of the lack of instructions, no case is made out, at this stage for referring the matter to Mediation.

7. The Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of the execution petition to the counsel for the Judgement Debtor within three (3) days.

8. The Judgement Debtor is directed to remain personally present in Court on the next date of hearing.
