I.A. 33930/2024 (Application on behalf of the Plaintiff under Section 151 of the CPC for clarification/further directions with respect to the order dated 28.06.2024)

1. Learned counsel for the Applicant/Plaintiff states that the Plaintiff in this application seeks a direction for suspension of the website enlisted at prayer clause (b) i.e., <https://celebritycruiseandhotels.com/>.

1.1. He states that this application was filed in July, 2024 and during the intervening period on a recent examination, it is seen that this website is currently *inaccessible*.

1.2. He states that, however, to avoid any future misrepresentation through this website, the Plaintiff seeks registrant details of this website from Defendant No. 6.



2. Learned counsel for Defendant No. 6 states that the registrant details along with IP address will be provided to the Plaintiff within three (3) weeks.
3. Learned counsel for the Plaintiff states that with respect to the mobile numbers mentioned in the prayer clause (c) i.e., 7369028263 and +9123941932, the Plaintiff seeks action against the said mobile numbers which are using their corresponding WhatsApp accounts for accepting fake bookings in the name of the Plaintiff. He states that, however, currently it appears that the WhatsApp account registered against the said numbers have been deactivated.
4. The Plaintiff is granted liberty to approach the concerned Telecom Service Providers ('TSP') for obtaining the details of the registered owner of these mobile numbers. The TSP upon receiving the request from the Plaintiff along with a copy of this order will provide the requisite details within two (2) weeks.
5. For ease of reference, the prayer clause (b) and (c) read as under:

“(b) Pass an order in the present proceedings to include the additional Impugned website - <https://celebritycruiseandhotels.com/> to be taken down/suspended/blocked/ deleted in addition to the directions laid down in Order dated June 28, 2024;

(c) Pass appropriate orders directing Defendant No.4 to suspend/block Defendants' phone numbers i.e. 7369028263 and +9123941932 which are being used towards fake bookings, by sharing dubious payment links and playing fraud on unwary customers;”
6. Learned counsel for the Plaintiff states that the URLs on the social media platform of Facebook and Instagram are currently inaccessible and therefore, at this stage, he is not praying for any relief vis-à-vis the said



URLs qua Defendant No. 9.

7. In the meantime, Defendant No. 9 is directed to provide the Basic Subscriber Information (BSI) of the users, who posted these URLs along with IP logs to the Plaintiff within three (3) weeks.
