1. This is an application filed by the defendant nos.1 and 2 seeking enlargement of time to file the Written Statement. The written statement by the defendant nos.1 and 2 stands filed.
2. The learned senior counsel for the plaintiff submits that the delay in filing of the Written Statement can be condoned, subject to some condition.
3. Accordingly, the delay in filing of the Written Statement is condoned, subject to the condition that the defendant nos.1 and 2 shall pay a costs of Rs.10,000/- to the plaintiff.

10. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of any documents, the same shall be sought and given within the timelines.
