1. This is a suit for declaration and permanent injunction instituted by the plaintiff claiming in respect of certain properties left behind by his deceased father, who passed away on 06.11.2019. The defendants happen to be his mother and real brother, who are arrayed as defendant No.1 and 2 respectively.

2. Learned counsel for the defendants is present on advance notice. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the defendant that the properties, the details of which are mentioned in para 3 of the plaint do not belong to the deceased father of the plaintiff and rather



defendant No.1 is the absolute owner thereof.

3. Issue notice. Notice is accepted by the learned counsel for the defendants. Respondent no.1 who is a senior citizen laments that the plaintiff has forcibly taken away the documents of her properties and harassing her all the time. Let written statement be filed within four weeks from today.

4. List before the Roster Bench on 20.08.2024. In the meanwhile the *status quo* shall be maintained in respect of properties which are mentioned in I and II of the para 3 of the plaint.

5. Since the parties are members of the same family, they are directed to appear before the learned In-charge, Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre on 15.07.2024 at 2.30 PM to explore the possibility of reaching an amicable settlement.
