(a) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, including a writ of mandamus, directing the Respondent to rectify the discrepancies in the Petitioner's scorecard for the Joint Entrance Examination (JEE Main) - 2025 published on 01 May 2025;

(b) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, directing the Respondent to recompute the Petitioner's NTA Score and to declare a revised result accordingly, in respect of the Petitioner's Application No. 250310384651;

(c) Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction, thereby mandating the Respondent to put in place an effective and transparent grievance redressal mechanism for addressing discrepancies in



Recorded Response Cards and related grievances of candidates, in a time-bound manner;

(d) Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction, thereby constituting an independent committee comprising senior officials, academicians, and technical experts to enquire into the discrepancies and systemic lapses in the conduct of the JEE (Main) - 2025 examination process, and to submit a report within a time-bound period as deemed appropriate by this Hon'ble Court; and,

4. Issue notice. Ms. Pankhuri Shrivastava, the learned counsel for the respondent no.2/NTA accepts notice. Likewise, Mr. Arjun Mitra, the learned counsel for the respondent nos.3 & 4 accepts notice.
5. Let counter-affidavit be filed within a period of four weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.
