By way of the present application, the respondent/wife seeks vacation of order dated 14.10.2022 whereby, on his own undertaking, the petitioner/husband was directed to deposit Rs.50,000/- within three months, out of which Rs.20,000/- was to be deposited within 45 days; in addition to paying Rs.3,000/- per month as *ad-interim* maintenance to the respondent.

Issue notice.

Mr. Rohit Tripathi, learned counsel for the respondent accepts notice; and seeks time to file reply.

Let reply be filed within 06 weeks from today; rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within 04 weeks thereafter; with copies to the opposing counsel.

After making some submissions, the petitioner states that he is ready and willing to pay to the respondent the balance sum of Rs.30,000/- by



10.07.2023 *i.e* the next date of hearing in the matter; and shall also continue to pay Rs.3000/- per month towards *ad-interim* maintenance.

Subject to the said payments being made, Mr. Tripathi, on instructions of his client who is present in court, states that he will not press the pending execution petition before the learned trial court.

Re-notify on 10th July 2023, the date already fixed.
