1. This is a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023 for quashing of FIR no. 200/2014 dated 15.05.2014 registered under Section 306 IPC at PS Sagarpur, Delhi and all proceedings arising therefrom.

2. The Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR was registered in



the year 2014 but more than 11 years have passed without any chargesheet having been filed or any credible evidence, surfacing against the petitioner.
