By way of the present petition, the petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 assailing the Order dated 06.04.2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge (ASJ), Dwarka Courts, Delhi in Criminal Appeal No.29/2022.
