2. Application stands disposed of.

W.P.(C) 8382/2025 and CM APPL.36491/2025 (Stay)

3. This matter has been listed pursuant to mentioning today.
4. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner (through his mother and natural guardian) seeking urgent orders in view of the critical medical condition of the petitioner.
5. It is averred in the petition that the petitioner was diagnosed with brain tumor in February, 2025 and has been receiving treatment in the respondent no.2 hospital (G.B. Pant Institute of Post-Graduate Medical Education & Research) since then.
6. It is submitted that the medical condition of the petitioner has gradually worsened and consequently, the petitioner was shifted to the



Intensive Care Unit (ICU) of the respondent no.2 hospital on 24.05.2025. Thereafter, on 25.05.2025, the petitioner was taken out of the ICU for conducting a CT Scan whereupon he suffered a stroke, and as a result of which, was required to be put on a ventilator (life support). The petitioner has been on life support since the said date.

7. It is submitted that recently, the petitioner was removed from the ICU and put in the general ward. The ostensible reason given by the hospital authorities (respondent no.2) was that they are trying to find a suitable ICU bed with a ventilator for the petitioner.

8. It is submitted that the medical condition of the petitioner is critical and he may not survive if he is not shifted into the ICU with a ventilator facility.

9. Issue notice to the respondents, on necessary steps being taken by the petitioner, through all permissible modes, including electronically.

10. Considering the aforesaid emergent circumstances, the respondent no.2 hospital (G.B. Pant Institute of Post-Graduate Medical Education & Research) is directed to immediately make an endeavour to arrange for the petitioner to be shifted to the ICU (with ventilator facility) as expeditiously as possible, preferably today itself. The respondent no.2 is also directed to provide the best possible treatment to the petitioner.
