1. As per office noting, LR no. (v) & (vi) of plaintiff have been served on 17.11.2025 and defendant no.7 has been served on 07.03.2026. But they have failed to file reply. Therefore right of LR no. (v) & (vi) of plaintiff and defendant no. 7 to file reply stands close.
2. Pleadings qua other parties are already complete.
3. Heard. As per the captioned IA plaintiff had died on 20.03.2025. Plaintiff is survived by Mrs. Sashi Chaudhary (wife), Ms. Nikita Chaudhary (daughter), Ms. Aashima Chaudhary (daughter), Mr. Mayank Chaudhary (son), Mr. Agrim Singhal (Son of Pre-deceased daughter



namely Late Archana Singh (Son of Pre-deceased daughter namely Late Archana Singhal). This is a suit for partition and rendition of accounts. The right to sue survives against the LR of deceased plaintiff.

4. In view of the above discussion, the LR of plaintiff as mentioned in the captioned IA are substituted in place of plaintiff. Requisite entry be made in respect of LR of plaintiff.
5. LR of Plaintiff is directed to file amended memo of parties within four weeks.
6. The captioned IA is disposed off accordingly.
