**CCP(O) 79/2024 (by the plaintiff no. 1 under Section 12 of the Contempt
of Court Act, 1971 read with Section 151 of the CPC)**

1. In the present application, the plaintiff no. 1 has alleged wilful disobedience of the orders dated 12.11.2020 and 29.10.2021.
2. The present suit is for partition. This Court *vide* order dated 12.11.2020, while issuing summons in the suit had directed the parties to maintain *status quo* as to possession and title in respect of the suit properties till the next date. Subsequently, *vide* order dated 29.10.2021, it was directed by the Court that interim order shall remain in force till further orders.
3. Learned counsel submits that the suit properties have been enumerated in para 3 of the plaint, a perusal of which shows that shop bearing no.B-16, New Timber Market, WHS Kirti Nagar, Delhi-110015 is one of the suit property. Similarly, in the list of moveable properties –



Honda City Car, as well as, Polo Car have also been mentioned.

4. It is the contention of the plaintiff no.1/applicant that recently he has come to know that the defendants have sold/transferred the suit properties i.e., Shop No.B-16, New Timber Market, WHS Kirti Nagar, Delhi-110015, as well as, Honda City Car and Polo Car, without permission of the Court in wilful disobedience of the *status quo* order passed by this Court.
5. In view of the above, issue notice to the defendants by all permissible modes.
6. Reply to the application be filed within four weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.
7. List on 23.01.2025.
