1. The instant appeal under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 has been filed on behalf of the appellant seeking the following reliefs:

“i. To call the trial court record and Allow the appeal and set aside the impugned order/judgment dated 30.04.2024 passed by Ld. P.O., MACT-01, District North, Rohini, Delhi in MACT No. 517/2017 titled as Parmod @ Padam Chakra Diwakar Vs. Rinku Saroj & Ors. whereby the appellant is directed to pay Rs. 52,99,350/- i.e. 70% of the sum of Rs. 75,70,500/- as compensation along with interest @ 9% per annum.from the



date of filing the petition till the date of award.

ii. Pass such other further order/orders, as may be deemed fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case may also be passed in favour of appellant in the interest of justice.”
