1. Petitioner is defending a civil suit which is pending before Family Court.
2. Issue is, essentially, between the family members as the suit has been filed by the parents-in-law of the petitioner herein.
3. Petitioner had filed an application under Order VII Rule 11 CPC which was dismissed and since after dismissal, learned Trial Court noted that she had not filed any written statement and her time to file such written statement had already expired, her right to file written statement was closed and her defence was also struck off. These orders are under challenge.
4. Fact, however, remains that now the aforesaid application has been moved seeking stay.
5. It is informed that the matter is fixed before the learned Trial Court on 07th instant for final arguments and in case the arguments are heard and the

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suit is, eventually, decreed, it would cause irreparable loss and prejudice to the petitioner herein.

6. Nobody appears from the side of the respondent despite advance service through email upon learned counsel for respondent.

7. In view of the urgency cited, learned Trial Court is requested to defer the hearing of final arguments to a date subsequent to the one given by this Court.
