1. Next date in the present appeal is 15.10.2025.
2. However, by way of aforesaid application, appellant seeks early hearing.
3. Reason assigned is to the effect that an Execution Petition has been filed by the decree-holder and the learned Executing Court has already directed for appointment of *Bailiff*.
4. During the course of arguments, when asked, learned counsel for appellant volunteered to deposit 50% of the decretal amount with the learned Executing Court within four weeks from today.
5. Accordingly, no further coercive process be taken in the Execution Petition if appellant deposits 50% of the *decretal-amount* before the learned



Executing Court within four weeks.

6. Application stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
