CM APPL. _____/2026 (to be numbered) (for waiver of cost by petitioner)

1. At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the reply filed by the petitioner to the application under Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, could not be placed on record as costs of Rs.5,000/- had been imposed upon the petitioner *vide* order dated 19.05.2025. He further submits that an application seeking waiver of the aforesaid costs has been filed, however, the same is returned under objections. Upon learned counsel re-filing the aforesaid application, the Registry is directed to number the same and place it on record.
2. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the costs of Rs.5,000/- imposed *vide* order dated 19.05.2025 are waived. The reply filed by the petitioner to the application under Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 is directed to be taken on record.
3. The application is disposed of.
