By way of the present petition filed under section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973, the petitioners seek reinstatement/restoration of case FIR No. 152/2002 under sections 406/420/468/471/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at P.S.: Prasad Nagar, which was quashed *vide* judgment dated 29.07.2015 passed in CRL.M.C. No. 1393/2012 titled **Sunita Gupta & Ors. vs. State & Ors.**, based upon a Family Settlement Deed dated 29.01.2012, premised on the contention that the persons against whom the FIR had been registered have failed to comply with the terms of the settlement.



2. Explaining the delay in the matter, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits, that in relation to the performance of the obligations under Family Settlement Deed dated 29.01.2012, the parties have been in mediation for all this time.
3. After making some submission, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks further time to satisfy the court as to why the present petition, which evidently suffers from long delay, should be entertained.
