ORDER

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07.01.2025

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking reinstatement/restoration of the FIR No. 152/2002, registered at Police Station Prasad Nagar, under Sections 406/420/468/471/34 IPC.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the FIR in question was quashed by this Court *vide* order dated 29.07.2015 passed in Crl.M.C. No. 1393/2012 on the basis of settlement arrived at between the parties. He submits that the parties had amicably resolved their disputes and had executed a Family Settlement Deed dated 29.01.2012, terms whereof were to be acted upon in future.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner invites the attention of the Court to the Family Settlement Deed dated 29.01.2012 to contend that Rajiv Gupta (respondent no. 2), was obliged to execute relinquishment deed and NOC in



favour of Sanjiv Gupta's family, i.e., the petitioners herein. He submits that the said part of the settlement has not been acted upon by Sh. Rajiv Gupta. Accordingly, it is urged that the FIR in question may be revived.

4. In view of the above, issue notice. The learned APP for the State accepts notice.

5. On the petitioners taking steps, issue notice to respondent nos. 2 to 4, by all permissible modes, returnable on 17.04.2025.
