CRL.M.(BAIL) 1216/2022 (for suspension of sentence) & CRL.REV.P. 658/2022

1. The revisionist has assailed appellate order of learned Court of Sessions whereby the Magisterial order of conviction and sentence under Section 138 Negotiable Instruments Act was upheld. Broadly speaking, the case set up by the present respondent no.1 is that he advanced a cash loan of Rs.20,00,000/-, towards repayment whereof the revisionist issued two post-dated cheques of equal amounts, which got bounced. The defence taken by the revisionist was misplacement of those two cheques, regarding which he lodged a police complaint also. But according to the Trial Court as well as Appellate Court, the revisionist could not prove the misplacement of those cheques and also could not prove the alleged police complaint. Neither the alleged weeding out of police complaint was proved nor even the original stamped complaint was produced.

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2. In the above circumstances, after addressing partly, learned counsel for revisionist seeks adjournment to take instructions.
3. Relist on 09.05.2025.
4. Interim orders to continue till next date of hearing.
