The petitioner seeks *mandamus* to the respondents to conduct joint survey and inspection of the disputed site in order to identify the unauthorised encroachment and illegal construction and take action against office bearers of the society in accordance with law and ensure that no further unauthorised construction is carried out; the petitioner has also



sought demolition of the construction already carried out. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that managing committee of respondent no.3 cooperative group housing society is carrying out the illegal construction of a temple and suit filed by the petitioner to injunct them got dismissed.

3. Learned counsel for respondent no.2 accepts notice and seeks and is allowed to file Status Report to confirm the alleged construction within two weeks. Notice be also issued to respondents no.1 & 3 on steps to be taken within three days, returnable on 16.07.2025 before the Roster Bench.

4. Learned counsel for petitioner presses for ex parte interim relief to restrain any further construction. But in the absence of the current status at the spot, we are not inclined to pass any such order till Status Report is filed.
