1. The learned counsel for the appellant submits that the learned Tribunal has erroneously relied upon the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of ***Master Mallikarjun v. Divisional Manager, the National Insurance Company Ltd. & Anr. (s) in Civil Appeal No. 7139/2013***, to award lumpsum compensation.
2. He submits that the victim, at the time of accident, was 12 years of age and has suffered 57% permanent physical disability.
3. He submits that in terms of judgment passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of ***Master Ayush v. Branch Manager, Reliance General Insurance Company Limited and Another : (2022) 7 SCC 738***, at least minimum wages of skilled labour, as applicable in Delhi, should have been considered for the purpose of compensation.
4. He submits that the victim was also entitled to 'Loss of Future Prospects'.
