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1. Mr. Arjun Mitra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent nos.3 and 5 submits that present petitioner did not get herself registered for seat allocation with Joint Seat Allocation Authority for counseling to engineering seats in IIT and NIT+, therefore, the present petition would only be an academic exercise.
2. He submits that all the seats of IIT have already been allocated and only four seats are left, of which two are at IIT Kharagpur and remaining two are at IIT BHU, in the stream of Architecture, which are meant for the candidates belonging to OBC-NCL (Female Supernumerary).



3. Mr. Rajesh Ranjan, learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submits that allegations of petitioner are also directed against TCS. He prays for time to file an application to implead TCS as party.
